About University

Maa Shakumbhari University, a State University located in Saharanpur, Uttar Pradesh, India, was established under The Uttar Pradesh State Universities Act of 2019. The university was initially named Saharanpur State University but later was renamed Maa Shakumbhari University by the Government. The university's foundation stone was laid on December 2, 2021, marking its establishment by upgrading the Government Degree College, Punwarka, which was founded in 1999.



Maa Shakumbhari University now oversees all government and private degree colleges in the districts of Saharanpur, Muzaffarnagar, and Shamli, which were previously affiliated with Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut. Currently, the university affiliates 8 Government, 11 Aided, and 193 Self-Financed colleges. The university envisions becoming a global centre of excellence in education, research and training by pursuing the following mission:

- To provide highest standards of learning in academic sphere.
- To attain specialization in interdisciplinary research and training in contemporary fields.
- To produce high skilled professionals in concerned field of knowledge.
- To evolve global leadership qualities in learners through mentoring and extension activities.

Stepping Stone to Accreditation

To promote continuous quality assurance and improvement, and to identify the strengths and weaknesses, Maa Shakumbhari University has consistently encouraged its affiliated colleges to pursue NAAC accreditation. To further enhance the university's reputation and credibility, ensuring that it meets or exceeds specific educational standards, Prof. Sudhir Kumar Pundir, Principal, Sanatan Dharm College, Muzaffarnagar, was appointed as the NAAC coordinator for the university.



The journey of accreditation was no easy feat and significantly supported by the Vice Chancellor and NAAC coordinator of the university attending the **"NAAC Manthan"** on April 4-5, 2022, at Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University (AKTU), Lucknow, U.P. The event, which invited all State Universities of Uttar Pradesh, focused on guiding institutions in their preparation for the NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council) evaluation. The program was further enhanced by the esteemed presence of the Honorable Chancellor, Deputy Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh, Shri Brijesh Pathak Ji, Agriculture Minister, Shri Surya Pratap Sahi Ji, and Technical Education Minister, Shri Ashish Patel Ji.

NAAC MANTHAN : PHASES

To kickstart the NAAC documentation process, Sanatan Dharm College, Muzaffarnagar, an affiliate of Maa Shakumbhari University, organized a program titled "NAAC Manthan - 1" on June 20, 2022. The Honorable Vice Chancellor, Prof. H.S. Singh, was invited to this event to inspire and motivate the college faculty to pursue their first cycle of accreditation.



Following the guidelines provided by NAAC and pursuing the path to accreditation, the college hosted "NAAC Manthan - 2" on July 2, 2023. The event featured the Honorable Vice Chancellor, Prof. H.S. Singh and Prof. Mridul Gupta, IQAC Coordinator of C.C.S. University, Meerut and discussions regarding the accreditation process were held. Subsequently, another interactive session titled "NAAC Manthan - 3" was organized at Sanatan Dharm College under the guidance of Prof. Sudhir Kumar Pundir, bringing together esteemed members from various colleges affiliated with the university to discuss NAAC-related matters.





ACCREDITATION STARTED

Following the accreditation of Sanatan Dharm College with a prestigious 'A' grade by NAAC (First Govt-Aided College in U.P. to achieve this grade at that time) in its first cycle on December 14-15, 2023, **"NAAC Manthan - 4"** was held to share the college's accreditation journey. The Honorable Vice Chancellor and distinguished Principals from different affiliated colleges were invited to this event to celebrate the achievement and address their queries. This session aimed to assist other colleges in their accreditation efforts by sharing the experiences and insights gained by Sanatan Dharm College, Muzaffarnagar.



NATIONAL SUMMIT OF INSTITUTIONAL LEADERS (NSIL)

Prof. Sudhir Kumar Pundir, Principal, Sanatan Dharm College, Muzaffarnagar and university coordinator, NAAC, also attended the three-day "National Summit of Institutional Leaders (NSIL)- Institutions for National Development 2024," organized by Vidya Bharati Uchcha Shiksha Sansthan, with support from the University of Lucknow and the Department of Higher Education, Government of Uttar Pradesh. 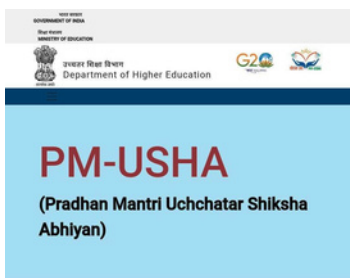

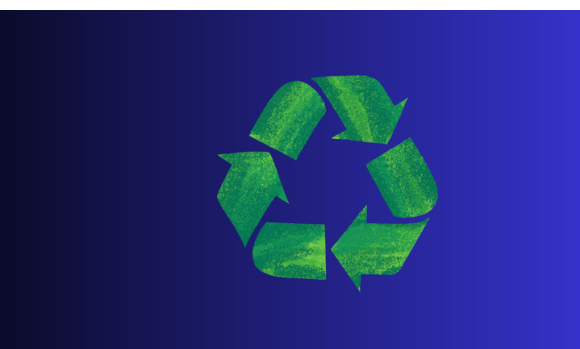
